Toaster or Toaster Oven **Foreman Grill** Space Heater **Electric Skillets/Woks** Hot Pot or Hot Plates Candles (any kind)/Candle Warmers Anything that hangs from the ceiling (fire code violation) **Torch Lamps/Lava Lamps** Air conditioner **Incense or Incense Burner** Firecrackers/fireworks Weapons of any kind (BB guns, Pellet guns, water guns, Knives) – includes any toy version Pets (except fish in a 10-gallon or smaller tank) Anything that has an exposed heating element
