**Theme House Interview/Presentation requirements: (Interviews are the week of March 20<sup>th</sup>-24<sup>th</sup>)**

1. Provide detail about your proposed programs that your theme house will conduct each month (from September to April) and a program for each semester. These programs should support your chosen theme for the house.
2. Part of the Waldorf University mission is service and giving back to the community, to this end each theme house must complete one educational activity or service project for the campus each semester. What two programs does your group plan to do?
3. Each house must provide a typed housing contract with rules, possible division of responsibilities, who will get a room to themselves or share the double room where applicable, what steps will be

taken by house members if you lose member over the summer or during the year, and possible consequences for members not helping with monthly programs. All members of the house must comfortable with what is in the contract. All members must sign and adhere to what is written in the contract. *A printed and signed copy will be left with the selection committee. If an issue is brought to Residence Life staff, the theme house RA will refer to the typed contract during the scheduled mediation.*
