## Music Scholarship Audition Information

A generous scholarship program supports the music making tradition at Waldorf College. Scholarships are available for vocalists, instrumentalists, and keyboard players and are allocated based upon musical achievement, professionalism, and particular ensemble needs.

All music auditions will be held in the *Odvin Hagen Music Center*. Individual auditions may be scheduled to coincide with campus visits. These private auditions must be scheduled in advance with your Admissions Counselor and the Music Office. The Music Department may be reached at (641) 585-8177.

## Specific Audition Criteria

### Instrumental

- An etude or solo appropriate for high school solo & ensemble festival.
- Major scales through 4<sup>b</sup> & 3<sup>#</sup> (C, F, B<sup>b</sup>, E<sup>b</sup>, G, D, and A Major).
- Sight-reading.

### Keyboard

- One solo which represents your technical and music mastery level.
- Sight-reading.

### Vocal

- Two (2) solos of contrasting style appropriate for high school solo & ensemble festival. The pieces should be memorized. We strongly suggest one should be sung in a foreign language.
- An accompanist can be provided if requested.
- When scheduling your audition, include the composers' names and the keys of your songs.
- Sight-reading.

## Waldorf Music Scholarship Requirements

- Membership, in good standing, in applicable ensemble(s).
- Participation in all tours of said ensemble.
- Serving as an accompanist as directed by the keyboard faculty.
- Private study during your first year, with a minimum grade of B-. Waldorf College music scholarships are renewable for up to four years for full-time students meeting the above requirements. Music Education students may apply for a one-semester extension if required for their student teaching practicum.
