This sample plan of study mainly is to show the core Nursing classes of the RN to BSN Program. Your plan of study will be built with your academic advisor to meet your individual needs and may add any remaining elective or general education coursework. This could increase the length of the program and/or the total credit needed to complete the BSN program., along with total tuition and fee costs. Thus this plan is based on a student who would need two additional general education courses and two additional courses at the 3000 or higher level to meet the requirement for a bachelor degree.
